The Jo Daviess County Sheriff's Office, Jo Daviess County Highway Department and the Illinois Department of Transportation are asking all drivers to be aware of the Winter Weather Advisory in effect from 9P Saturday through noon Sunday. This weather will bring up 1 to 3 inches of snow with wind gusts up to 35 MPH. **Due to the blowing and drifting snow, and sub-zero temperatures, road crews will have a difficult time keeping up with the ice on the roadways and drifting snow.**

The Sheriff's Office will only respond to emergency calls. All non-emergency calls will be followed up on after the storm. Do not to travel unless absolutely necessary.

If you do travel, any assistance by responding agencies may be severely delayed.
