Minutes from May 19, 2014 were reviewed by the members. Marc McCoy made the motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by JoAnn Hesselbacher. All in favor, motion passed.

IPLAN Community Needs Assessment Update – Lori stated that the Board of Health recommended Obesity, Diabetes and Cardiovascular Disease for the 3 top priorities for the upcoming IPLAN.

Kim Barrett updates on prostate cancer screenings – Kim reviewed the last 3 months of the health screening data. The number of participants were down for May but June & July they were back up.

Midwest Medical Center Updates – The online medical records are going well. Some offices are being switched around to make room for a new optometrist office.

Report from Holly Shadle of the Well Women Program – Holly stated that the Illinois Breast & Cervical Cancer Program (IBCCP) new grant year started July 1st. This year's total caseload is 472 women with Jo Daviess caseload at 78. Quite a few women are transitioning to Medicaid through ACA. The Wise Woman Program new grant also started on July 1st. This year's total caseload is 220 women. Please continue to refer women to this program.

Report from American Cancer Society – No one from the American Cancer Society was in attendance. Maggie Kluck has emailed the following information:

2013 Jo Daviess County Data Highlights:

- Served 32 Jo Daviess County cancer patients; 18 were newly diagnosed and 6 were uninsured or on Medicare/Medicaid.
- The majority of patients that received American Cancer Society services were female (23 to be exact.)
- We served 10 breast cancer patients with services in your local community.
- The programs that were utilized the most were local Look Good Feel Better sessions, lodging assistance and free wigs through your local American Cancer Society wig boutique.
- Relay for Life of Jo Daviess County had 14 teams and over 120 participants at their local Relay for Life event at the end of May in Galena. Your community raised more than \$57,000 for the American Cancer Society's mission of finishing the cancer fight. Thank you!

Other Items – Marc McCoy is working on starting a Prostate Cancer Support group for Galena. Marc will update the coalition on his progress at the next meeting.
