IPLAN Community Needs Assessment Update – The results of the survey that was sent out and received back from the community has been tallied. Cancer is still one of the three top priorities for Jo Daviess County. We are not sure what type of Cancer the Coalition will focus on depending on what the Board of Health recommends at the next board meeting.

Kim Barrett updates on Prostate Cancer Screenings – Kim shared the last 2 Health Screenings' data with the Coalition. Lori explained with the accreditation process, information has to be measurable. Kim will see about adding to the screening application form about getting permission from the patient to follow up on abnormal prostate screenings.

Midwest Medical Center Updates – Peg was not able to attend. Kim updated us on the Emergency Medical Records training that the hospital & clinic are partaking in.

Report from Holly Shadle of the Well Women Program – Holly was not able to attend.

Report from American Cancer Society – No one from the American Cancer Society was in attendance. Libby Miller reported that the Relay for Life fundraiser is May 31st from noon until midnight at the Galena High School.

Other Items – Marc McCoy would like to start a Prostate Cancer Support group for

Galena. He said that Mercy has one in Dubuque and he plans on attending to see how they run theirs. Lori will check with Nancy for approval. The Coalition discussed possible ways to promote the Prostate Cancer Support group through the media such as Facebook, ads in the Flash, Galena Gazette and Telegraph Herald.
