MEETING MINUTES

Minutes from August 18, 2014 were reviewed by the members. Marc McCoy made the motion to approve the minutes as presented, seconded by Kim Barrett. All in favor, motion passed.

IPLAN – Identified health priorities are: 1. Obesity 2. Cardiovascular Disease and 3. Diabetes. The IPLAN still has to be approved by the State. This is the last Cancer Coalition meeting due to the new IPLAN that starts in 2015. The future plans for the Health Dept. would be to have one Wellness Coalition and link together or branch with each health priority. One of the goals would be to expand the Hypertension/Cholesterol Screenings with follow up done through the Health Department on blood draw results. The current Cancer Coalition members are invited to participate in the new Wellness Coalition.

Kim Barrett updates on prostate cancer screenings – There were 29 clients at the last clinic; 9 were men and only 1 had the PSA test which was normal. Kim gave the coalition members reports for the last 3 months.

Midwest Medical Center Updates – Peg Dittmar has discontinued her diabetic support group.

Report from Holly Shadle of Well Woman Program – Holly was not able to attend. She did send an email that says: “We are still looking for referrals for the program as our numbers continue to decrease due to women signing up for ACA. Our caseload attained for the first quarter was 9.11%. We are going to be out in each county leaving program information at laundry mats, churches, etc. If you have any areas you think would be beneficial, please let me know. We will be starting in Jo Daviess and Carroll Counties. The WISEWOMAN program has started but with IBCCP numbers down we are not doing well with numbers there as well as the woman has to be enrolled in IBCCP to be eligible for WISEWOMAN.”

Report from American Cancer Society – No one in attendance.

Wellness Committee Members – This was covered already under IPLAN.

Other Items – There is a Search Committee for the hiring process of the new Health Department Administrator. Interviews will most likely take place after the first of the year.

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Lori spoke about the Obesity Coalition and how they are involved in collecting BMI data from the schools, articles written by members and published in the newspaper, how our IT department is able to monitor the number of hits on our Obesity Coalition website and the Rethink Your Drink campaign.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 am.
