Sending upcoming events to Lori to add to the website – Lori asked the Coalition to view the website regularly and send her any updates.

Market the website to agencies/communities, etc. – Brochures are being updated and printed to hand out at various activities throughout the year. Shirts will be ordered with the Wellness Coalition printed on them for members to wear to activities whether they are participating in a run or setting up a table with information.

Strategic Plan for next year – Lori stated that Elizabeth wants the Coalition to be a resource hub of information utilizing the website.
