The Illinois Supreme Court requires electronic filing (e-filing) of court documents for civil cases in the Illinois Supreme, Appellate and Circuit Courts. The eFileIL initiative began with Order M.R. 18368 and will be phased in to meet the mandatory dates identified in the Supreme Court's Order, over the coming months.

## Timeline

**July 1, 2017** — e-filing required in the Supreme Court and five districts of the Appellate Court. In addition, all 102 trial courts are to transmit the record on appeal through eFileIL to their respective reviewing court.

**January 1, 2018** — all civil cases shall be e-filed in the trial courts. Also effective January 1, 2018, e-filing shall be mandated through eFileIL in 87 counties not exempted by the Supreme Court's Order. To ease their transition to eFileIL, the 15 counties exempted in the Order may continue to use their existing e-filing systems.
