MINUTES

There was not a quorum present for this meeting.

1. New Business

- a) Duct cleaning. Four bids packets were received. The committee members opened the bid packets and the bids were recorded.
 - i. Steamatic, Dubuque. Courthouse - \$9,387. Public Safety Building - \$4,693. Total - \$14,080.
 - ii. Bomar, Freeport. Courthouse - \$24,550. Public Safety Building - \$16,720. Total - \$41,270.
 - iii. Giese Sheet Metal, Dubuque. Courthouse - \$11,700. Public Safety Building - \$6,100. Total - \$17,800.
 - iv. Indoor Air Technologies, Victor, NY. Courthouse - \$10,440. Public Safety Building - \$6,960. Total - \$17,400.

The committee discussed the various proposals and if the proposals included provision for paying Prevailing Wage. The proposals were reviewed for completeness as per the Request for Proposals (RFP). The proposal from Steamatic was not complete. The committee discussed who would inspect the job. The committee discussed the multi-year HVAC project that still has two years left to be completed. The consensus of the committee is to place an unfunded request in the FY2007 budget process in the amount of \$18,000 for the duct cleaning.
