

# EARLY VOTING SCHEDULE



County Clerk Angela Kaiser informs voters they may cast a ballot prior to the November 3, 2020 General Election without offering a reason or an excuse for wanting to vote early.

Pursuant to Article 19A of the Illinois Election Code, Early Voting for the General Election for all Jo Daviess County precincts will be conducted at the office of the County Clerk in the Jo Daviess Courthouse at 330 N. Bench Street in Galena.

Early voting begins on Thursday, September 24, 2020 and continues through Monday, November 3, 2020 weekdays from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. and starting October 19, 2020, weekdays from 8:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Saturday voting will be available on October 24 and October 31, 2020 from 9 a.m. until noon.

Any voter validly registered in Jo Daviess County may vote during the early voting period after showing proper identification. State law requires that a registered voter casting an early ballot must display a current driver's license, a state-issued ID card or another government-issued ID with a photograph.

If you are not currently a registered voter, State law does allow for grace period registration and voting in person, Wednesday, October 7, 2020 through Tuesday, November 3, 2020, only at the office of the County Clerk, and does not allow the voter to vote at the polls on Election Day.

Vote by mail applications can be submitted until Thursday, October 29, 2020, if requesting a vote by mail ballot, or until Monday, November 2, 2020, if requesting the vote by mail ballot in person. Thursday, October 29, 2020 is the last day the County Clerk can mail the ballot to voters.
